

Mount Pleasant Top Ten List

- 10. Henry Clay Frick purchased the grounds of Standard Mines in December 1883 and soon built it up into one of the largest producers of bituminous coal and coke in the world. In 1893, the company displayed a scaled model of the operations at the Chicago World's Fair.
- 9. Company E of the 10th Pennsylvania National Guard was established in Mount Pleasant in 1888. The unit served with honor and bravery in many important conflicts, including the Spanish-American War and both World Wars. Today, the unit is known as HQ Company 1st Battalion 110th Infantry.
- 8. The Bryce Brothers Glass Company built a state of the art glass factory along Bridgeport Street in 1896. From 1896 through 1965, the company manufactured high-end crystal that was used in the White House by several U.S. presidents and by other dignitaries in U.S. embassies around the world.
- 7. The Doughboy monument at the corner of Diamond and Main Streets was dedicated November 11, 1924 to honor the fifteen members of Company E 110th Infantry who lost their lives in battle during World War I. Fifteen gold stars encircle the pedestal under the statue's feet, one for each fallen soldier.
- 6. The borough honors it's Veterans with one of the largest Veterans walls and one of only several digital tablets in the country. The most fitting and touching tributes to Veterans ever in a small town.
- 5. John White Geary, the first mayor of the city of San Francisco, CA and governor of Pennsylvania from 1867-1873, was born near the current borough limits.
- 4. The Pittsburgh Steelers, then known as the Pirates, held their second annual training camp in Mount Pleasant in the fall of 1934.
- 3. Mount Pleasant Memorial Hospital opened its doors to the public on January 20, 1904. It was one of only two hospitals in the county at the time.
- 2. Mount Pleasant Borough was incorporated on February 7, 1828, making it the oldest existing borough in Westmoreland County.
- 1. April 14, 2016 Lt. Governor Michael Stack visits Mount Pleasant borough.
